COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Exploring basic ideas of using texture to create a print. We will cover print room Health and Safety and use etching presses. Collograph is a very sensitive print and can be printed using 2 techniques:

- Inking up and print as a relief print
- Ink up but use intaglio method where you wipe away surface ink

The inks we use are oil based, wearing so an apron is essential (we can provide).

These techniques can develop and produce exciting images which can lead to textile, illustration, and fine art projects.

An Apron.
