ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

You must have GCSE grade 9-4 (A*-C), in Maths and English or Functional Skills Maths and English.
You must hold a Level 2 in Childcare and be working or volunteering in industry for a minimum of 12 hours a week.
You must also hold a clean DBS check.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

NCFE CACHE Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce (Early Years Educator)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed to help practitioners who already hold a level 2 childcare qualification to upskill and gain a Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce (Early Years Educator). This qualification prepares learners to become Early Years Educators, enabling them to work with children from birth to 5 years and gain knowledge of working with children aged 5 to 7 years.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

There are 23 units that will be covered and assessed. Some of the units that will be covered are:

- Support healthy lifestyles for children through exercise
- Working in partnerships
- Engage in professional development
- Support children's transitions to school
- Support children's additional needs
- Promote children's physical development

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

- Written assignments
- Placement observations
- Longitudinal studies

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Text books
- Stationery – Such as USB, ring binder, dividers, pens, paper, plastic wallets
- Access to IT an advantage

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Upon achievement of this qualification, students will gain their licence to practise and it is intended that students will be able to enter the workforce as Early Years Educators. Students can progress into various job roles in the statutory,



voluntary or private sectors such as:

- Assistant in Children's Centres
- Practitioner in nursery schools
- Practitioner in reception classes in primary schools
- Pre-school worker
- Foundation Degree
