ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 5 GCSE's, grade A*-D (9-3) including English & Maths and an interview, or Level 1 Hairdressing and GCSE grades A*-D (9-3) in English and Maths.
- A positive reference from your tutor and a proven track record of good attendance and punctuality.
- Willingness to follow uniform guidelines and comply with college attendance and punctuality standards is essential.
- Candidates will need to be able to practise at home and provide clients for assessment at the East Surrey College Salon, Escape.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

- Level 2 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing
- GCSEs in English or Maths (for those who have not achieved Grade 4 (C) or above)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The VTCT Level 2 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing is a qualification that will develop your practical skills in:

- The creative art of cutting or dressing women's hair.
- How to provide effective shampooing and conditioning services.
- The artistic skill of colouring and lightening hair.
- How to provide a good consultation service for your clients.

You will learn how to create a hair and beauty image, plait and twist hair, colour hair using various methods for semi and temporary colour, display stock and promote products and services to clients. You will develop a sound knowledge and understanding of the theory of each unit and gain the employability skills needed to become a successful hairdresser. You will be expected to participate in relevant work experience.
