### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

On this focused and informative course, you will learn how to draw and paint a portrait from a studio model. You will learn new techniques for depicting proportion and construction of features as well as creating a finished portrait. You will use acrylics at first although oils may be used if preferred. Your learning will be supported by demonstration and one to one teaching, enabling you to progress with confidence toward a finished portrait.

### **EQUIPMENT NEEDED:**

Please bring drawing materials to the first lesson, including charcoal, 4B and 6B pencils, a sketchbook (Seawhite are recommended). You will also be required to buy an adequate set of acrylics and a range of flat headed brushes. You will be required to purchase further materials and equipment - your tutor will advise you.
