COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is a Barbering qualification that will develop practical skills in; the creative art of cutting men's hair, the specialist work of cutting facial hair and how to offer a good consultation service for clients.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Cut hair using basic barbering techniques
- Cut facial hair to shape using basic techniques
- Follow Health and Safety practice in the salon
- Client consultation for hair services

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, exams and assignments.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- East Surrey College uniform is required: plain black clothing, smart clothes and black leather shoes
- Specific equipment kit required (£150 approximately)

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Further hairdressing courses or employment in a barbers, hairdressers or freelance work.
