

DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

34 weeks starting on Tuesday 17 September 2024, 18:00-21:00.

VENUE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill, RH1 2JX.

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

Candidates will need to be able to practice at home and provide clients for assessment at the Escape Salon at ESC. Willingness to follow uniform guidelines and comply with college attendance and punctuality expectations are also essential.

Please note that this is an intensive course and will require great commitment to complete. There will be a lot of research and assignments to be completed independently, and a high level of attendance will be required in order to achieve this qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

There are no formal entry requirements for this course, but an appropriate level of literacy is required and an interview is necessary.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 Certificate in Beauty Specialist Techniques.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This is a professional course where you will gain a recognised qualification to practice beauty therapy. You will study treatments such as facials, make up, manicure, waxing, and lash & brow treatments. You will also receive essential training covering health and safety, salon hygiene and customer care.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Provide eyelash and brow treatments
- Provide facial skin care
- Follow health and safety practice in the salon
- Apply make-up
- Client care and communication in beauty related industries
- Provide manicure treatments
- Waxing

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, exams, and assignments.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- East Surrey College uniform is required (approximately £50).
- Specific kit or equipment is required (approximately £220).

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Employment in the Beauty industry, self-employment, or additional certificate level qualifications in related areas such as massage, depilation, and nail services etc.
