

Education and Training (DET) Level 5 Diploma Course Code – MET0000050

Teacher Training

DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

This is a part-time programme lasting 40 weeks, starting from Monday 13 August 2024, 17:30 - 20:30.

VENUE:

This course is offered at East Surrey College.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

You will need to demonstrate level 2 in English and be qualified in the subject you wish to teach, and have access to 100 teaching practice hours. If you've completed level 3 and level 4, this is the perfect way to extend your skills as a trainee teacher. You may, however, be eligible to complete level 5 without completing level 3 or level 4, depending on your classroom experience and existing qualifications – please contact us to discuss your exact circumstances.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

On successful completion of this course students will achieve a Diploma in Education and Training (DET) Level 5 qualification (City & Guilds 120 Credits).

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The Diploma in Education and Training (DET) Level 5 course is aimed at teachers who want to teach in further education (FE) colleges. Additionally, this course is suitable for new teachers working in other sectors including Adult and Community Education, trainers in the public and private sector as well as those working with 14 – 19 year olds in a vocational setting. It will enable you to become an effective, critical and professional teacher or trainer with well-developed knowledge, skills and understanding of your role and the sector you are operating within.

DELIVERY MODEL:

This course combines face-to-face lessons in the classroom, remote delivery via Teams, and one-to-one tutorials.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

The qualification covers the knowledge and skills required by teachers/trainers in the further education and skills sector, such as:

- Teaching Learning and Assessment in Education and Training
- Developing Teaching, Learning and Assessment in Education and Training
- Theories, Principles and Models in Education and Training
- Wider Professional Practice
- Teaching in a Specialist Area
- Action Learning

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

You will be assessed through a combination of assignments, a portfolio of teaching evidence and observation of teaching or training. Essay type assignments (theory assessment), planning & delivery of at least eight sessions – one hour minimum (practical assessment). The sessions can be done on any topic of your choice, preferably the subject that you specialise in. You will be observed and assessed by a tutor/assessor for at least eight hours out of the 100 hours of teaching practice.









EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Access to a computer/laptop.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

The course may lead to employment as a qualified teacher or to increased responsibility and promotion within your current role. Successful completion of the course will allow you to apply for the Qualified Teacher, Learning and Skills (QTLS) status which will allow you to teach in secondary schools. For those completing DET at level 5 there may be opportunities to progress to a BA in Education and Professional Training.

COURSE FEE:

Price: £2225

If you are 19+ on 31 August 2023 and meet the ESFA (Education & Skills Funding Agency) residency criteria, the standard fee will apply unless you qualify for free tuition.

The full fee will apply if you are aged 19+ on 31 August 2023 and you do not meet the ESFA residency criteria or if there is no Government funding for this qualification.
