PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

Learners are expected to have completed the Games Design & Development Level 1 Award course **OR** have a good understanding of Games Design fundamentals.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This qualification is designed for learners to develop an initial idea into a game prototype.

You will develop an initial idea into a 2D or 3D game. You will create visuals to show what the game will look like, as well as a design specification that documents all aspects of the game. You will then create the assets for the game engine and add interaction to make a playable game. You will obtain feedback on your work for review and further development.

You will learn the basics of how to create a simple 2D or 3D game within the Unity game engine, developing such things as character and enemy movements, picking up collectables, keeping score, win conditions and creating menu screens.

Learning Outcomes:

1. Be able to understand different types of computer games.
2. Be able to design a computer game in response to a client brief.
3. Be able to develop and test a computer game.
4. Be able to review a computer game.
