

DURATION, DAY, DATE AND TIME OF THE COURSE:

12 weeks starting Tuesday 12 January 2025, 15:00 – 18:00.

VENUE:

This course combines remote delivery with face-to-face lessons in the classroom at East Surrey College, Gatton Point, London Road, Redhill, RH1 2JX. Observations of practice are carried-out in the workplace.

PRIOR KNOWLEDGE/SKILLS REQUIRED:

There is no requirement for learners to have achieved prior qualifications or units prior to undertaking this qualification.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Learners should be proficient in the use of the English language. Learners must be occupationally competent in the vocational area in which they are providing coaching and mentoring.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

On successful completion of this course learners will achieve a Level 3 Gateway Qualifications Certificate in Coaching & Mentoring – Level 3 Training (22 credits).

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The course is mapped to the national occupational standards for coaching and mentoring and includes demonstration of skills in the workplace. This qualification is suitable for people who are teaching, coaching or training and/or who need to be able to coach and mentor individuals in a range of settings including on-the job or in a training company, FE College, Adult Learning Service or a company's internal training department.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Understanding Mentoring (workbook)
- Mentoring Practice (observation of practice)
- Engage Others in the Learning and Development Process (workbook)
- Preparing for the Coaching Role (Workbook & observation of practice)
- Coaching Skills (Workbook)

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

You will be assessed through a combination of workbooks, and observations of coaching and mentoring.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

Access to Microsoft Teams.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

Learners can progress into following qualifications:

- Level 3 Award in Education and Training
- Level 5 Diploma in Teaching
- Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement
- Level 4 Award in the Internal Quality Assurance of Assessment Processes and Practice



COURSE FEE:

Standard Fee £811, Full Fee: £1108

Eligibility for fully funded:

- Aged 19 and above and earn below the earnings threshold or be unemployed
- Aged 19 to 23 and not have achieved a full level 3

Eligibility for co-funded:

- Home address in the GLA
