East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year Full-time.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Plumbing Level 1 Diploma and at least 1 GCSEs grade 9-4 (A\*-C) in English or Maths.

### WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 Technical Certificate in Plumbing.

### COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course covers all elements of practical work; topics will include Health & Safety, Cold and Hot Water, Central Heating, Sanitation & Drainage, Maintenance, Working Relationships and Quality Development. There is a large proportion of self-study and research tasks and the ability to manage your own time effectively.

### UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Health & Safety and Industry Practices
- Plumbing Processes
- Electrical and Scientific Principles
- Hot Water
- Cold Water
- Central Heating
- Sanitation & Drainage

### TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

One end point multiple choice exam and one Synoptic practical assessment.

### EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

All students will be required to wear college uniform. Steel toe capped boots must be worn at all time when in the workshops. It is recommended that all students purchase a course Textbook.

You will need to purchase uniform items such as a polo shirt, trousers and other personal protection equipment (PPE). Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.
