

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must be aged 19+.

English and Maths at Grade 9-3 (A*-D) or BKSB initial assessment on interview to show working at Level 1 or above. We expect to provide an opportunity to study GCSE Maths and English alongside the course for those students whose skills fall just below the Grade 4 (C) standard at GCSE.

A work history or voluntary experience in a health-related environment will be advantageous, although not necessary. A high level of motivation is required to complete the course.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 2 Certificate in Skills for Working in the Health and Social Care industry.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed for adults not already in possession of suitable Level 2 qualifications as an approved route to an Access to HE Diploma.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

The structure of this Pre-Access course will be divided into a variety of study areas:

- Understanding the Medical Profession
- Preparing for a career in health and social care
- Communication in health and social care
- Anatomy and physiology of body systems
- Understanding health promotion and health education
- Protection and safeguarding in health and social care
- Dementia awareness
- Ethical issues in health care
- Understanding how to handle information in health and social care settings
- Interview skills personal study skills
- Person Centred Approaches in health and social care

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

This Level 2 Pre-Access Certificate is a continual assessment programme that allows students to constantly improve and develop their portfolio. Assessment comes in a range of forms including reports, essays, discussions, debates, practical assessment and observations, projects and presentations.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- Stationery – writing pad, file, pens, plastic wallets, USB memory stick
- Access to IT facilities at home is an advantage

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

With successful completion of the Level 2 Certificate in Skills for Working in the Health and Social Care Industry, you can apply to study for the Access to HE Diploma in Nursing or Social Work and ultimately, a degree programme at university.
