

VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year, Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Beauty Therapy Level 2 and GCSEs grade 9-4 (A*-C) in English and Maths.

You will need a positive reference from your tutor and a good attendance record.

You will also need to be able to practise at home and provide your own models to be clients in the East Surrey College salons.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

Level 3 Diploma in Beauty Therapy Treatments.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A specialist vocationally related technical qualification that will complement the knowledge, understanding and skills gained at Level 2 and is focused on producing highly proficient, professional Beauty Therapists.

The course concentrates on the anatomy and physiology of the body and will introduce students to body treatments.

You will learn all aspects of the beauty industry including how to contribute to the financial effectiveness of the business and how to promote additional services to clients.

You will also be expected to participate in relevant work experience.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Monitor and maintain health and safety practice in the salon
- Client care and communication in beauty related industries
- Provide body massage
- Provide facial electrotherapy treatments
- Provide body electrotherapy treatments
- Apply microdermabrasion
- Apply massage using pre-blended aromatherapy oils

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

A portfolio of practical work, exams and assignments.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

East Surrey College uniform is required - approximately £50.00.
