VENUE AND DURATION OF COURSE:

East Surrey College, Gatton Point, Redhill, RH1 2JX, 1 year Full-time.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Painting & Decorating Level 1 Diploma and GCSEs grade 9-3 (A*-D) English and Maths.

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS WILL I GET?

City and Guilds Painting & Decorating Level 2 Diploma.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

During this practical course you will complete seven units. You will learn about construction operations, health & safety, teamwork, wall coverings, decorative special finishes and working platforms.

UNITS/TOPICS COVERED:

- Preparation of different types of surfaces
- Hanging a range of wallpapers to walls and ceilings
- Application of oil and water-based paints
- · Storage and handling of materials
- Basic working platforms

TYPE OF ASSESSMENT:

Online tests and a portfolio of evidence.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

To meet health and safety requirements within our realistic work environment, all students will be required to wear college uniform. Steel toe capped boots must be worn at all time when in the workshops.

WHERE CAN IT LEAD?

This course can lead to progression to employment as a trainee Painter & Decorator, a Level 3 Diploma, NVQ or an Apprenticeship.

COURSE FEE:

If you are under 19 on 31/08/2025, tuition is free. If you are 19 or over, please consult Client Services for advice and guidance on funding and eligibility.

You will need to purchase uniform items such as polo shirt, trousers and other personal protection equipment (PPE). Please be aware that there may be additional costs for equipment and educational visits. This information will be available from the curriculum staff at interview.
